

VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, ILLINOIS
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Illinois have the responsibility of regulating the parking of vehicles within the Village limits; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has previously passed various Ordinances dealing with the parking of vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the Village has previously adopted a Code of Ordinances and the President and Board of Trustees desire to set forth in a single section of said Code all ordinances regulating or prohibiting the parking of vehicles within the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: There is hereby added to the Oakwood Municipal Code in Title 10 the following chapter:

10.24.010 Unlawful Parking.

No person shall park or stop any vehicle, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic-control device, in any of the following places.

- (A) On a sidewalk.
- (B) Blocking or interfering with access to any street, alley, or driveway.
- (C) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- (D) On the roadway side of a parked vehicle, so as to be double parked.
- (E) At any place where official signs or markings prohibit stopping or parking.
- (F) In an area for a period longer than the time restrictions posted by official signs or markers.
- (G) In any place which will interfere with the free flow of traffic over a public street or alley.

- (H) In a manner which will permit a portion of the vehicle to extend beyond officially marked individual parking spaces.
- (I) In any area officially marked as a bus stop, cross walk, or loading area.
- (J) Along South Oakwood Street south of Route 150 on either side of the street between the hours of nine p.m. and six a.m.
- (K) Delta Street or its shoulders.

Section 10.24.020 Parking Semi-Trailers.

No person shall park or leave standing any idling semi-truck or tractor or commercial vehicle weighing in excess of 12,000 pounds for a period of time in excess of 15 minutes in any eight hour period within 150 feet of any residence.

The prohibition hereby imposed shall not apply to parking or standing of such vehicle for the purpose of delivering materials or equipment to be used in the repair, alteration, remodeling or construction of any building or structure for which a building permit has been obtained. The prohibition shall not apply to any truck stop facility even within 150 feet of any residence.

Section 10.24.030 Parking at Curb.

No vehicle shall be parked with the left side of the vehicle next to the curb, and it shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle in a street other than parallel with the curb and with the two right wheels of the vehicle within 12 inches of the regularly established curb line. However, upon those streets that have been marked for angle parking, vehicles shall be parked at the angle to the curb indicated by those marks.

Section 10.24.040.040 Parking Vehicles for Sale.

It shall be unlawful to park any vehicle upon any street for the purpose of displaying it for sale, or to park any vehicle upon any business street from which vehicle merchandise is peddled.

Section 10.24.050.

No truck except those registered as class B vehicle (except any truck temporarily stopped while in actual transit) shall be parked upon Oakwood Street from the North village limit to the South village limit.

Section 10.24.060.

No semi-tractor/trailer combined units, except those temporarily stopped while in actual transit, or those in the process of delivering goods to a destination within the Village shall be parked upon any street, alley, or public property within the Village limits of the Village of Oakwood. No semi-tractor may be parked on any street, alley, or public property within 50 feet of any semi-trailer.

Section 10.24.070.

No person shall leave standing any idling vehicle or park any vehicle in front of any of the garage doors of the public buildings located at the following site: (a) 102 Lake Bluff Drive (Oakwood Emergency Rescue Service), (b) 108 South Scott Street (Oakwood Police Department), (c) 527 South Oakwood Street (Oakwood Fire Protection District); (d) on Finley Street in front of the Oakwood Public Library.

Section 10.24.080.

If the driver is unable to be located the vehicle's registered owner will be issued the violations unless he/she can provide the identification of the driver of the vehicle at the time of the violation.

Section 10.24.090 Authority of Superintendent of Streets and Alleys.

The Superintendent of Streets and Alleys is authorized and directed to place the official signs and markers where parking is limited or prohibited by this Title.

Section 10.24.100 Notice of Violations.

Notice of violation of this chapter shall be given in writing to the person committing the violation, either in person or by leaving the notice in or on the vehicle involved in the violation. All fines levied in accordance with this chapter shall be payable at the office of the Village Hall within 10 days from the date of the notice of violation.

Section 10.24.110 Unpaid Fines.

Any violation of this Title may be enforced through the administrative adjudication of code violation procedures of the Village pursuant to an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Danville, Illinois

Section 10.24.120 Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined not less than \$50.00, nor more than \$1,000.00 for each offense except \$100 shall be

the minimum fine assessed for violating §10.24.070; and a separate offense shall be deemed committed for each day during or in which a violation occurs or continues.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 days after its publication.
