

**VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 15-5-11-1**  
**2015 PREVAILING WAGE ACT ORDINANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Illinois has enacted an Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works, approved June 26, 1941, as amended, (820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et. seq.*) [hereinafter referred to as the Prevailing Wage Act]; and

**WHEREAS**, the Prevailing Wage Act requires that the Village of Oakwood, as an Illinois municipal corporation, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages, as defined in said Act, of laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of the Village who are employed in performing construction of public works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood:

**SECTION 1:** To the extent and as required by the Prevailing Wage Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Oakwood is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Vermilion County, Illinois area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of the month of June of the current year, a copy of which determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Village of Oakwood. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in said Act shall be the same as in said Act.

**SECTION 2:** Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Oakwood to the extent required by the Prevailing Wage Act.

**SECTION 3:** The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested person, in the main office of the Village, this Ordinance or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this Ordinance or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect, shall be attached to all contract specifications for public works construction for the Village.


**SECTION 4:** The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this Ordinance to any employer and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees, who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

**SECTION 5:** The Village Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Illinois Secretary of State Index Division and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.


**SECTION 6:** The Village Clerk shall cause to be published in pamphlet form a copy of this Ordinance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the Ordinance is effective and that this is the determination of the corporate authorities of the Village.
