

ORDINANCE NO. 16-4-11-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE  
OAKWOOD LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE Village of Oakwood, Illinois have previously adopted a Liquor Control Ordinance, and

WHEREAS, said Liquor Control Ordinance establishes various classifications and numbers of licenses to be issued; and,

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance establishes the procedure for increasing the number of licenses available for issuance; and,

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village of Oakwood have complied with said procedure, including but not limited to causing notice to be given of not less than ninety (90) days by publication in a newspaper having general circulation within the Village of Oakwood, Illinois of the time, date and location of a meeting of the Board of Trustees considering an increase in liquor licenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the Village of Oakwood, Vermilion County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: The Liquor Control Commissioner shall be and is hereby authorized to issue a total of 5 Class D Liquor Licenses.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 days after its passage and publication.
