

ORDINANCE #16-6-13-1

VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, ILLINOIS

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
OAKWOOD LIQUOR CONTROL CODE**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood have previously adopted a Liquor Control Ordinance, to-wit: Ordinance No. 84-12-10-2, which has subsequently been incorporated into the Oakwood Municipal Code as Article XI; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood believe it is in the best interest of the Village that the said Article XI be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Vermilion County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: Section 11.02.325 of Chapter 11.02 of the Oakwood Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“11.02.325 Location Restrictions: No license shall be issued for the sale at retail of any alcoholic beverages within 100 feet of any church, school, hospital, home for the aged or indigent persons, or veterans, their wives or children, or any military station. Each place of business licensed under this chapter which is located within the jurisdiction of a local zoning ordinance shall comply with the provisions of such ordinance.”

Section 2: Section 11.02.330 of the Oakwood Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“11.02.330 Closing Hours:

The closing hours of establishments licensed under this ordinance for all classes shall be 12:00 midnight to 7:00 a.m., Sunday through Saturday.”

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and publication in pamphlet form.
