## **ORDINANCE NO. 17-9-11-1**

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH MAIN STREET AND OLMSTEAD STREET

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Illinois have received complaints regarding traffic safety at the intersection of North Main Street and Olmstead Street; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood have authority under the statutes of the State of Illinois to erect stop signs within the Village on village streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Illinois as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Southbound, northbound, eastbound and westbound vehicular traffic shall be required to stop at the intersection of North Main Street and Olmstead Street.

<u>Section 2</u>: The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to erect stop signs at the intersection described in Section 1.

<u>Section 3</u>: Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$750.00 for each offense.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its publication or the erection of appropriate signs, whichever occurs later.

Section 5: Section 1 of this ordinance shall be added to the Oakwood Municipal Code at Section 10.02.010.
